EARN WHILE YOU LEARN

As an apprentice, you'll work for an employer, and you will earn a wage. The minimum wage for an apprentice is £5.28 per hour but wages will vary as there are many employers who are willing to pay more than the minimum.

We work with a variety of different employers, ranging from small to large, who offer great opportunities to 'earn while you learn'. - Only include relevant info

- 5 Avoid fancy fonts, use 11 as your minimum font size
- 6 Spell check!
- Get someone to proofread it
